

BRUSH & BRANCH COLLECTION

SERVICE OPTIONS

BRANCHES & BRUSH (FOUR FEET OR LESS IN LENGTH) - WEEKLY TRASH COLLECTION DAY

Branches or brush four feet or less in length should be disposed of on your regular trash collection day. The material should be tied into bundles of fifty pounds or less and up to five bundles per week may be placed out for disposal. Branches or brush may also be cut up and disposed of in paper compost bags or trash cans marked with a yard waste sticker. Yard waste in bundles, bags or cans is collected the last week of March through the second week of December.

CHIPPER SERVICE (OVER FOUR FEET IN LENGTH)

Chipper Service runs the 1st week of April through the 1st week of October. Branches and limbs longer than four feet in length, up to four inches in diameter should be stacked with all of the cut ends in one direction for forestry chipper service. Stumps, logs, vines, or roots cannot be placed out for disposal.

April Until Memorial Weekend

From April until Memorial Weekend chipper crews automatically circulate through each residential neighborhood approximately every fifteen working days.

Memorial Weekend Through Beginning of October Service

On the Tuesday following Memorial Day and through the end of September service is on a request only basis.
