### Situational Awareness

- Wayne County announces 34 new Livonia residents have tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 24 hours.
- Wayne County's vaccine clinic at the VisTaTech Center at Schoolcraft College is accepting walk-in appointments for all Wayne County residents age 16 or older on Friday and Saturday from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Appointments can also be made by calling (866) 610-3885 during business hours.
- COVID-19 hospitalizations across Michigan have decreased by nearly 500 since Monday, with 3,652 adults currently hospitalized for COVID-19 in the State.
- A Centers for Disease Control and Prevention advisory panel has recommended lifting the pause of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine.
- The CDC has updated [guidance](#) on COVID-19 vaccine information for specific groups, including those with underlying medical conditions, those who may be pregnant or breastfeeding or those who have allergies.
- Livonia Public Schools is releasing information via email to the parents and guardians of students age 16 and older who are interested in their child receiving the Pfizer vaccine next week.
- Meijer is partnering with the State of Michigan and FEMA to schedule COVID-19 vaccine appointments at Ford Field in Detroit. More information, including on how to sign up for those eligible, can be found [online](#).
- **Please note:** Those with appointments are asked to arrive promptly at the time of their appointment with photo identification showing a Livonia address.

### Actions Taken

- In compliance with guidance from the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, the Livonia Public Library is currently closed until May 3. Curbside pick-up services remain available, and pick-up appointments can be made by calling (734) 466-2491. - In compliance with guidance from the State Court Administrative Office, the 16th District Court is returning to phase one of its opening plan. At this level, the Court conducts as much business as possible virtually, and access to the Court remains by appointment only.
